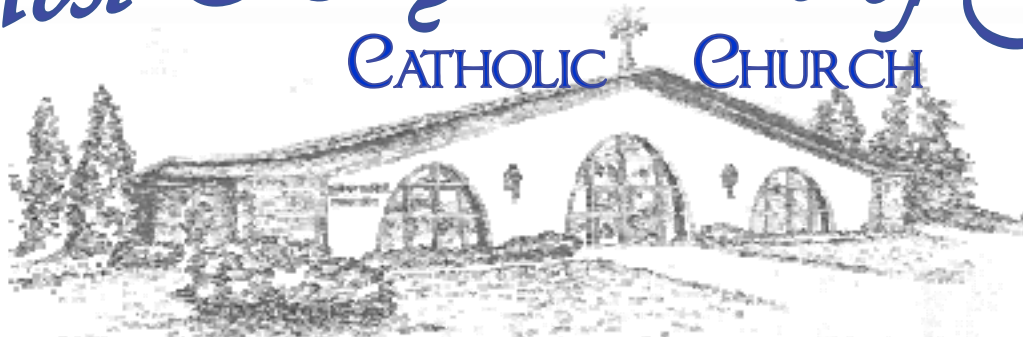

The New Roman Missal

Some important changes in the English Mass:

There are more word changes over the wine – for example, “*Chalice*” instead of “*Cup*.” Chalice is what we usually use when we are referring to this sacred vessel. “*Chalice*” also highlights the formal ceremonial use of the vessel.

It is also used frequently in the Bible in reference to suffering (*Luke 22:42; Matthew 20:22*).

The covenant is “*Eternal*” instead of “*Everlasting*” in the new translation in English, “*Everlasting*” has a sense of time. “*Eternal*” is beyond time. God’s covenant cannot be measured.

“*All*” is replaced by “*Many*.”

It is clear in the New Testament that Jesus came for the salvation of all (*John 11:52; 2 Corinthians 5:14-15; Titus 2:11; 1 John 2:2*). But the Latin word that is used here means “*Many*.” It could be a reference to *Isaiah 53:12*, where it describes the suffering servant who bore the sin of “*Many*.”

At the back of the Church, there are hand-outs with the new translation of the people’s responses side-by-side with the current translation of the Mass. Please take a copy home so you can familiarize yourself with the upcoming changes. Remember that the new translation is not a change in Theology, but it helps us to see more clearly the connection between Scripture and the Mass prayers.

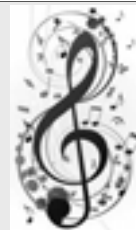
WAY Announcements (Youth Ministry)
