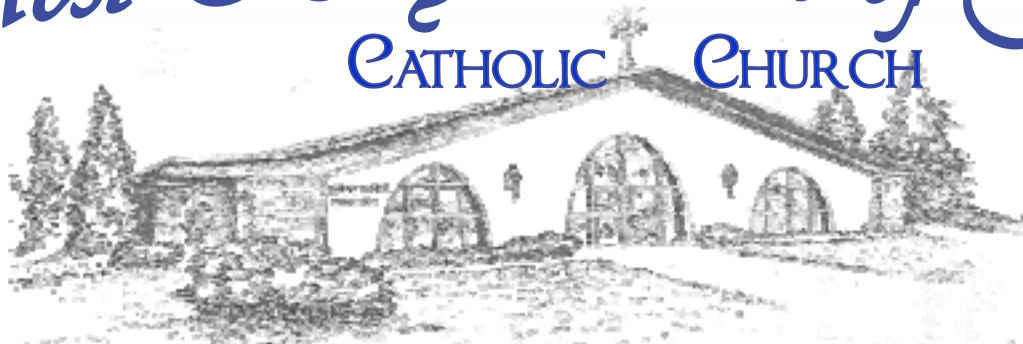


# Most Holy Name of Jesus CATHOLIC CHURCH

*From the Pastor's Desk*



**Below is a brief financial update of our parish:**

With the assistance of diocesan representatives, it was determined that the debt owed on the Early Childhood Center totaled approximately \$128,965. We will be paying whatever is possible from the Goodman account which can be used for any expenses that are acquired from ministry to children and the youth, as well as, for education. We are still in the process of determining the total debt of the parish and our average monthly expenses. Once these figures can be determined, we will be able to formulate and balance our parish budget for the upcoming year.

For the past several years, this parish community has paid 100% of the Annual Pastoral Appeal (APA). This greatly benefits the parish because any shortfall in meeting the APA goal must then come out of the parish's operating budget. This year our APA assessment is \$77,587. We currently have \$59,324 pledged and of that \$53,711 paid. As it stands right now, the parish needs to pay \$23,876 in order to meet the goal. The deadline to meet our parish APA goal is the end of this year. Your participation and support is greatly appreciated. Thank you for your continued generosity.

**The New Roman Missal**

The Eucharist is the Sacrament of Sacraments; it is the source and summit of our faith. During the Mass, bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ through the prayer of consecration. This process of turning bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ is called transubstantiation. In Catholic theology, transubstantiation means the change, in the Eucharist, of the substance of bread and wine into the substance of the Body and Blood of Jesus, while all that is accessible to the senses (sight, taste, smell, etc.) remains as before. The Words of Consecration are used in the process of transubstantiation. Below, you will see what the current Words of Consecration are and what the new Words of Consecration are going to be.

**Words of Consecration for the bread**

***(No changes in the text):***

Take this, all of you, and eat it:  
this is my body which will be given up for you.

**Words of Consecration for the wine**

**Currently:**

Take this, all of you, and drink from it:  
this is the cup of my blood,  
the blood of the new and everlasting covenant.  
It will be shed for you and for all  
so that sins may be forgiven.  
Do this in memory of me.

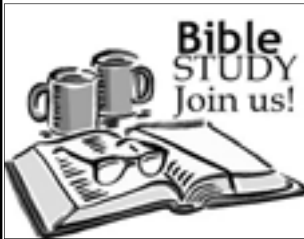
**New Roman Missal:**

Take this, all of you, and drink from it,  
for this is the chalice of my blood,  
the blood of the new and eternal covenant,  
which will be poured out for you and for many  
for the forgiveness of sins.  
Do this in memory of me.

**Una breve actualización financiera de nuestra parroquia:**

Con la ayuda de los representantes de la diócesis, se determinó que la deuda de la Escuela Preescolar es aproximadamente \$128,965. Vamos a pagar lo más posible usando la cuenta Goodman, la cual puede ser usada para cualquier gasto que provenga del ministerio de niños y de la juventud, al igual que para la educación. Todavía estamos en el proceso de determinar la deuda total de la parroquia y cual es el promedio de los gastos mensuales. Una vez determinemos estas cantidades, podremos formular y balancear el presupuesto de nuestra parroquia para el año que viene.

Los últimos años, esta comunidad parroquial ha pagado el 100% de la Apelación Pastoral Anual (APA). Esto beneficia mucho a la parroquia porque lo que falte para alcanzar la meta del APA, se tiene que sacar del presupuesto. Este año nuestra asignación del APA es \$77,587.
